GENESIS 1-5: CREATION, FALL, GENERATIONS

LISTEN

Talk about your day. Check-in to see how everyone is doing. Share blessings and challenges. This will help you connect God's word to your daily lives.

Read Genesis 1-5 at your own pace.

LEARN

Discuss what you've read. Begin with any of your own observations or questions. Discuss the questions for each chapter. Conclude with Luther's Four Questions (bottom).

Genesis 1 How did God create the world? How long (how many hours)? From what? What on each day? Why? What commands did God give Adam? Why? What did God declare about creation after day six? What did God do after finishing creation? Why?

Genesis 2 How did God originally water the earth?

What was different about the way God created people than rest of creation? from each other? Why? What job(s) did God give Adam? Describe the first wedding (vv.22-24). What is marriage (v.24)?

Genesis 3 How do we know who the serpent is? (Cf. Rev 12:9, 20:2) How did the serpent tempt Eve?

List the three ways the serpent tried to create doubt in Eve's heart. When did Eve sin?

Where was Adam? How did Adam sin? What did Adam and Eve do after sinning?

Whom does God hold responsible? List consequences to serpent, Eve and Adam.

What promise did God make? How else did God show love to Adam and Eve even after sin?

Genesis 4 What did Eve think when Cain was born? A/D – Adam and Eve taught their children about God.

Why did the LORD look down on Cain's offering? How did the LORD warn Cain of sin?

What sins did Cain commit? A/D – I commit the same sins as Cain. Are we our brother's keeper?

How did the LORD show mercy to Cain? How did Cain pass sin on to his family?

What is the meaning of the last verse, "men began to call o the name of the LORD"?

Genesis 5 What does it mean that "God created man in his image"?

In whose image were/are children born? How do we regain God's image?

Why do you think God recorded this genealogy? What do you notice about ages? Why so long?

What is the most important thing one generation can do for the next? What are consequences?

Four Key Questions

1. *What does this teach you about God?*
2. *What sin does this lead you to personally confess?*
3. *How does this point us to Jesus?*
4. *What does God want us to believe or do as we think about this?*

Pray from what you learned:
