GENESIS 6-11: FLOOD, NATIONS, BABEL

LISTEN

Talk about your day. Check-in to see how everyone is doing. Share blessings and challenges. This will help you connect God's word to your daily lives.

Read Genesis 6-11 at your own pace.

LEARN

Discuss what you've read. Begin with any of your own observations or questions. Discuss the questions for each chapter. Conclude with Luther's Four Questions (bottom).

How evil had people become? A/D – people are just as evil today.

How did they become so evil so quickly? What made Noah different? Are we different?

How did God feel about the people he had created? Didn't he know? How does God feel about us?

What did God decide to do? Why so drastic? Why wait 120 years? How much time do we have?

Why does God command Noah to build an ark? Whom would God save on the ark?

Why two of every kind of animal? A/D – the flood account is all about animals!

7:2 – different amount of animals? Why? Notice "according to their kinds" (7:14).

How old was Noah when flood began? What day did flood begin? How long did it rain? How long did waters flood the earth? When did mountain tops become visible? When did they come out? Why such detail?

What is the first thing Noah did after coming out of the ark? What did the LORD promise?

What command did God give? What gifts? What covenant? What sign?

How did Noah sin after planting a vineyard? How did sons react? Result?

Purpose of table of nations? Follow the line of promised Savior from Adam.

What happened to ages after flood? Why?

Luther's Four Questions

1. *What does this teach you about God?*
2. *What sin does this lead you to personally confess?*
3. *How does this point us to Jesus?*
4. *What does God want us to believe or do as we think about this?*

LOVE

Pray from what you learned:
